
This is your invitation to attend the Fifth Annual Clackamas Community College Orchestra Festival in Oregon City, Oregon on Saturday, April 7th, 2018 at Clackamas Community College. This festival is competitive and open to all string orchestra groups wishing to participate and will serve as an OSAA sanctioned competition for groups who wish to qualify for OSAA State Orchestra Competition. There is a fee of **\$215.00** per group for the festival.

Each group will be given 30 minutes of warm-up, 30 minutes of performance, and 30 minutes of clinic or sight-reading immediately following the performance. There will be two divisions. Division I will be Middle or Jr. High School Level. In this division, students will have a performance, adjudication and clinic. Awards will be given to the orchestras with the top three scores.

Division II will be High School level strings and in this division groups will have a performance, adjudication, and a adjudicated sight reading session as done in State Competitions. Awards will be given to the orchestras with the top three scores. If Symphony Orchestras are again interested in competing, we will have awards that scale to the number of groups competing.
