



CODE OF CONDUCT

As a participant in Athletic Activity in which I serve as a representative of Clackamas Community College, I understand that I am expected to abide by a code of conduct which will present a positive representation of the college, the department, my team, and myself.

I understand that behavior and conduct which may result in a negative attitude toward the College will subject me to disciplinary action at the discretion of an administrative representative.

CONDUCT WHICH I AGREE TO CONFORM:

- 1) I will maintain my academic eligibility (Please check which box applies to you)

If I am a first year participant- I understand it is my responsibility to be enrolled in and attending 12 credit hours the term(s) of participation and remain enrolled and attending throughout the entire term. I understand it is my responsibility to remain enrolled and attending even if my sport or participation has ended prior to the term's end. I also understand that if my sport continues across two terms, it is my responsibility to have passed a minimum of 12 credits the first term of participation in order to remain eligible for the second term the same year.

If I am a second year participant- I understand it is my responsibility to have passed a minimum of 12 credits the previous term of enrollment, as well as a minimum of 36 credits overall with above a 2.0 GPA in order to maintain my eligibility. I also understand it is my responsibility to be enrolled in and attending 12 credit hours the term(s) of participation and remain enrolled and attending throughout the entire term. If my sport season continues across two terms, it is understood that I must pass a minimum of 12 credits the first term of participation in order to remain eligible for the second term the same year, as well as maintain above a 2.0 GPA at all times.

- 2) I will refrain from using alcohol, tobacco and any illegal drug while in my role as a representative of the College. I understand that the use of tobacco, both in cigarette and smokeless form is considered a violation of this code of conduct. I understand that although marijuana is legal in the state of Oregon, it is still considered a banned substance by the NCAA and the federal government, and therefore still considered an illegal drug while I am a representative of the College.
- 3) I understand that I must remain in compliance with all team, conference (NWAC/NJCAA) and college rules.
- 4) I understand that I must obey all State and Federal laws.
- 5) I understand that I must exhibit behavior reflective of good sportsmanship at all times.
