Work Begins on Harmony Campus Redevelopment

OREGON CITY – The first phase of redeveloping the Harmony Campus at Clackamas Community College begins June 5 when project partners gather for a groundbreaking ceremony. Work on the new three-story building is expected to begin in July.

The 45,000 square-foot building will give a new home to the growing Health Sciences Division at the college. Two levels of the building will be devoted to nursing and allied health classrooms and laboratories. The ground floor will house student services such as registration, testing and advising, as well as community education and a college bookstore.

CCC has worked closely with partners in the area's growing health-care industry, business and Clackamas County to plan the facility. The new space will allow the college to increase capacity in existing health care programs and add new programs. A strong distance-learning component will serve students in rural areas of the state where health-care professionals are urgently needed.

Architects for the project are Yost Grube Hall and the contractor is Lease Crutcher Lewis.

The groundbreaking will begin at 9:15 a.m. on June 5 following CCC President Joanne Truesdell's "State of the College" address to the North Clackamas Chamber of Commerce. The address will take place at the Oregon Institute of Technology (OIT) conference center, 7740 SE Harmony Road, from 7:30 to 9 a.m. The groundbreaking will take place at the east end of the OIT building.
