### **Chuck Hudson**

Nov. 19, 1928-June 27, 2009

Oregon City resident Chuck Hudson died on June 27, 2009, at age 80.

He was born to parents Lowell and Mary Hudson on Nov. 19, 1928, in Pendleton, where he graduated from high school in 1946.

He served in the Army 7th Calvary from 1946 until his discharge in 1948.

He earned a bachelor's degree from Lewis and Clark College and a master's degree from Linfield College.

He was the athletic director at **Clackamas Community College** and was a teacher and coach in Milton-Freewater, Ione, Bend and at Clackamas Community College.

He was a member of the 1950 Hall of Fame track team at Lewis and Clark College and coached Ione High School to the first eight-man football state championships in 1960. He was the first athletic director at CCC, working from 1968 until his retirement in 1986 and bringing all sports to the college. He was inducted into the Northwest Athletic Directors Hall of Fame.

He belonged to the Methodist Church in Oregon City and at one time was the chairman of the Oregon City School Board.

He is survived by: daughters, Patty Rolen and Joan Ferguson; sons, Jim and Allan Hudson; brothers, Robert, Ron and Maurice Hudson; and grandchildren, Ryan and Tony Rolen, Amy, Amber, Trevor and Tyler Ferguson and Jessica, Chris, Nicole and Allan Hudson.

A celebration of life will be held at 5 p.m. on July 9, 2009, at the Oregon City High School auditorium, located at 19761 S. Beaver Creek Road, Oregon City 97045.

Memorial contributions may be made in his name to the athletic fund at Oregon City High School or to a scholarship fund at CCC.

A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. on July 11, 2009, at Bethany Evangelical Church, 450 S. Ivy St., Canby 97013.
