Recognition of Academic Excellence Policy

PURPOSE

Establishes regulation and conditions for recognizing students who achieve a measure of academic excellence.

SUMMARY

Students will be recognized for their academic excellence each term and at the College's commencement ceremony.

STANDARD

- 1. The Registrar's Office will post to the student's transcript an Honor Roll or President's List notation for each term a student has met all the following conditions. Students must:
 - a. Complete a minimum of 4 credits with grades of A, B, C, or D. A grade of P (pass) is allowed if there are a minimum of 4 credits of A, B, C, or D.
 - b. Earn a term GPA of 3.5 to 3.749 to be recognized as part of the Honor Roll.
 - c. Earn a term GPA of 3.75 or greater to be recognized as part of the President's List.
- 2. At the commencement ceremony, Honor Roll and President's List students whose cumulative GPA is 3.5 or higher on total credits earned at Clackamas will be recognized. Students with a GPA of 3.5 to 3.749 will be recognized with Honor Roll and students with a GPA of 3.75 or greater will be recognized with President's List. The honors status of Spring term graduates is determined by cumulative GPA through the last term graded.
