Residency Requirements for Graduation Policy

PURPOSE

Establishes definition and criteria for residency as it is used as a graduation requirement.

SUMMARY

To establish Clackamas Community College (CCC) residency for graduation for CCC earned college degrees and certificates and Adult High School Diploma (AHSD).

STANDARD

- 1. Residency is defined as follows:
 - a. Students interact with CCC faculty while the required credits are earned.
 - b. Students have access to instructional and student services
- 2. Residency of earning a minimum of 25% of credits at CCC and a cumulative CCC GPA of 2.0 is required for the following:
 - a. Two-year Associate degrees
 - b. Certificates of Completions:
 - i. Career Pathway
 - ii. Less Than One Year Certificate
 - iii. One Year Certificate
- 3. Adult High School Diploma students must pass a GED or ASE course attained through coursework or demonstrating competency. Additionally, students can earn credits through CCC college coursework.
- Credit for Prior Learning including but not limited to Advanced Placement, transfer credit, CCC administrative assessments or any other credit not earned at CCC do not count as residency
 - a. Exceptions can be made by the Vice President of Instruction/Student Services or Dean.

Example of Residency 25% Minimum Credits Requirement by Degree/Certificate Restated in Credits:
