Advanced Placement (AP) Procedure

PURPOSE

Establishes regulation and conditions for awarding college credit or determining course placement based on Advanced Placement (AP) scores.

SUMMARY

Clackamas Community College recognizes the College Board AP program.

PROCEDURE

1. The student must provide an official copy of the AP Exam scores from College Board to Graduation Services for evaluation and awarding of credit.
2. Graduation Services will be responsible for appropriately evaluating the AP Exam scores, posting to the student's transcript, and awarding credit based on ISP 371 Advanced Placement (AP) Policy and ISP 371A Advanced Placement (AP) Credit for Oregon's Community College and Universities Matrix.
3. In situations where a course equivalency is not listed on ISP 371A, Graduation Services will contact the instructional department to determine if credit can be awarded. In such situations, state guidelines must also be followed.
