## PRESIDENT SEARCH ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPLICATION FORM

When applying to serve on the Expanded President Search Advisory Committee, please consider the following criteria:

- **Commitment to the best interests of CCC.** Although members of the expanded committee serve as representatives of specific constituent groups, committee members will be expected to bring a "College-wide" perspective to their search work.
- **Record of active engagement in College affairs.** Relevant experience may include leadership or service at the College, or other activities that have broadened the applicant's perspective on the College.
- **Ability to maintain strict confidentiality.** Committee members will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement in order to foster frank discussion and protect the confidentiality of candidates and committee members during the process.
- **Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with others.** The work of the Committee will critically depend on listening and responding thoughtfully, not only to the greater CCC community, but to each other, as well.
- Willingness and ability to devote the time, energy, and attention required for full participation in the search process.
   Committee members will be expected to attend all meetings, which may be held during evenings and weekends. Throughout the process, Committee members must be willing to put in the time to review documents and come fully prepared to all meetings. Because of the intensive commitment required of Committee members, the Board will encourage efforts to make reasonable accommodations for them by their colleagues and supervisors.
- **Commitment to Equity and Inclusion**: Committee members should have a demonstrated track record of commitment to diversity and inclusion as evidenced by both their work and actions at CCC.
