	and during the term. If you change your enrollment status after receipt of aid, it may affect your financial
	aid award and future eligibility.
	Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) at both schools. Financial aid for future terms will not be
	released without receipt of HOME school prior term grades/transcripts.
