APPLE HEARING TOOLS

Sound Recognition

- Listens for certain sounds and uses on-device intelligence to notify you when a specific sound is detected.

Available on: iPhone, iPad

APPLE VISION TOOLS

VoiceOver

- Hear what's happening on your screen
- Describes people, objects, text, and graphs in great detail. Auditory descriptions of elements help you easily navigate your screen through a Bluetooth keyboard or simple gestures on a touchscreen or trackpad.

Available on: iPhone, iPad, Mac, Apple Watch, Apple TV, HomePod, iPod touch

Reduce Motion

- Decreases the movement of onscreen elements
- Some screen actions, such as moving between apps or launching apps, become visually simpler for motion sensitivity or to lessen strain on the eyes.

Spoken Content

- **Speak Screen** reads entire screen aloud.
- Control speech playback with **Speech Controller**.
- **Speak Selection** reads a specific range of text.
- **Highlight Content** highlights words or sentences as they're spoken.
- **Typing Feedback** speaks aloud each letter typed.
- In over 35 languages.
