- Reads text aloud, highlighting words and sentences as it goes
- Adjustable reading voice and speed
- Study tools, including the ability to add highlights and sticky notes, and create custom study guides
- Built-in dictionary for easy access
- Read-the-Web feature reads webpages aloud
- Does not read math content very well

BeeLine Reader

 Adds a color gradient that guides eyes from the end of one line to the start of the next making reading easier and faster.

- Records and syncs audio with typed notes
- Use on a computer, phone, or tablet
- Recorded audio is broken into visual segments
- Records computer audio as well as audio from your microphone with a feature for reducing background noise
- Add notes and slides from a different source

Echo I & Echo II Smartpens **DRC students only

- Record and sync audio with handwritten notes
- Record lectures and listen to audio without using a laptop, smartphone, or tablet
- No internet connection needed to record or listen to notes
- Use for remote or in-person learning and live or prerecorded lectures
- Backup files using the free desktop application on a computer or phone
- Creates a digital searchable copy of your notes (Echo II only)

Otter Al **Not offered or managed by the DRC

- Record and transcribe audio using any device
- Highlight transcript as you record (or after), and export highlighted sections
- Upload and transcribe audio from another source
- Upload images or take pictures while recording
- Search transcription
- Upload terminology to improve transcription accuracy
- Internet connection needed for live transcription (can record while offline, and then transcribe once re-connected)
- Transcripts must be exported to a program such as Word for additional annotation
- Free 600 minutes per month or upgrade to 6000 minutes for less than \$10; has a student discount
