In addition to the departmental requirements listed above, students must also complete coursework for university admission, general education requirements and BA/BS requirements. Meet with an Oregon Institute of Technology Academic & Career Coach to develop an effective transfer plan that will meet your individual needs.

General Education Requirements

- Students can transfer up to 9 credit hours of humanities electives into the BS program; (only 9 may be counted as humanities electives) these courses should be designated as humanities electives by Oregon Tech. However, only 3 humanities credits can be studio/performance based. Choose from the following Clackamas prefixes: ART, ENG, HUM, MUS, PHL, R, TA, Second-year Foreign Languages or other courses designated as humanities electives but the Oregon Tech Registrar's Office.
- To maximize useable credits toward the BS degree, the listed course is recommended.
- The Applied Psychology program requires 12 biological or physical science with lab. Choose from following Clackamas prefixes: BI, BOT, CH, G, GS, PH, Z or other courses designated as lab science electives by the Oregon Tech Registrar's Office. Please note that Oregon Tech does not grant science credit for computer science courses.
- Baccalaureate students must complete a minimum of 60 credits of upper-division work before a degree will be awarded. Upper-division is defined as 300- and 400- level classes at a bachelor's degree granting institution.
- Oregon Tech's Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology requires 180 credits.
