BA 206 Management Fundamentals	4	Accepted for BA 321 Principles of Management content at the lower division level. Students must take one additional upper division management class, at EOU, to replace the BA 321 upper division credits.		
BA 223 Principles of Marketing	4	Accepted for BA 312 Principles of Marketing content at the lower division level. Students must take one additional upper division marketing class, at EOU, to replace the AB 312 upper division credits.		

In addition to the departmental requirements listed above, students must also complete coursework for university admission, general education requirements and BA/BS requirements. Meet with an Eastern Oregon University Academic & Career Coach to develop an effective transfer plan that will meet your individual needs.

## **General Education Requirements**

- **180** Minimum credits required to graduate from EOU.
- **60** Minimum credits of upper division (300 & 400 level) credits required to graduate from EOU.
- **60** General Education Core credits required to graduate from EOU. Students should be especially aware of the 6 credits required for Artistic Process and Creation. (see http://www.eou.edu/registrar/gened) <u>EOU's General Education requirements are fulfilled with the completion of the AAOT.</u>
- 45 Minimum credits must be earned from EOU.
- 120 Maximum credits that can be transferred to EOU from accredited institutions.
- 12 Maximum career and technical education (CTE) elective credits that can be transferred.
- "C-" Minimum grade required in courses used to satisfy both Program and General Education requirements.
