

## Seasoned Adult Enrichment Program

...in its 23rd year is co-sponsored by the college. This program provides seniors in the county an educational experience that is designed and administered by “seasoned adults” (seniors/retirees) who actively participate in all aspects of the program – student, discussion leader, committee planner, host. Last year, this program provided nearly 25 sessions, serving more than 500 people.

### What programs are offered?

Inside you will find the spring term schedule. Morning sessions usually feature a new topic each week. Cookies and coffee are provided.

### How much does it cost?

Annual membership fee is \$30. As in the past, you may join per term for \$15. Attend a single session for \$3 per day. Pay at the door.

### Who designs the program?

People like you – members of the Seasoned Adult Enrichment Program! Instructors include SAEP members, community leaders, college faculty and guests from the community. Most of the instructors volunteer their time. All presenters have expertise in the subjects they teach – with a willingness and ability to share with others.
