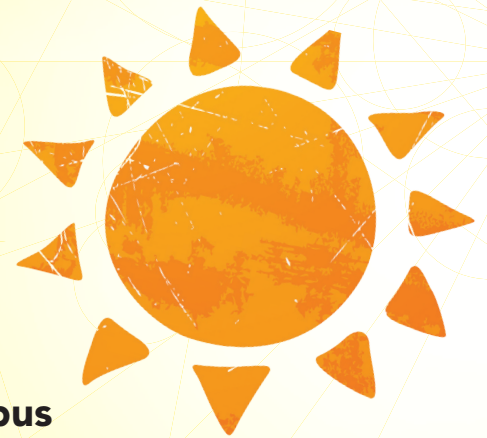

MEDICAL ASSISTING

Learn about the skills, and attributes of a successful Medical Assistant while exploring patient centered healthcare careers.

Discover the art of invention through hands-on activities using laser cutters and 3-D printers.

MFG-102 Makerspace: An Intro to Digital Manufacturing – 1 credit

INTRO TO LAND NAVIGATION

Develop real-world field skills in natural resource, fire, and outdoor careers. Students will gain practical experience using a map, compass, GPS, and mobile devices to navigate terrain and complete a real-world navigation course, then design and produce a digital map of the course! Perfect for students interested in outdoor adventure, wildland fire, environmental science, or just learning practical navigation skills.

CYBERSECURITY

Explore how cybersecurity affects everyday digital activities. Examine common online threats and apply practical protections through hands-on activities to secure personal accounts and devices. Develop skills and a mindset in threat recognition and explore cybersecurity career pathways in technology, policy, and business.

INTRO TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Explore Emergency Management through interactive, scenario-based learning. Gain hands-on experience with teamwork and decision-making in a simulated Incident Command Post environment. Students rotate through key ICS roles and participate in exercises set in realistic emergency scenarios and hazards relevant to Oregon.

Develop & learn the principles & best practices of organic fruit & vegetable gardening in the PNW.
