Clackamas Community College (CCC) in partnership with area high schools provides opportunities for students to earn college credit in the Automotive Service Technology program. There are multiple CCC classes that students may take through Advanced College Credit (ACC) program offered in your high school that help students progress toward a college certificate or degree.

Through the ACC program at Sabin-Schellenberg Professional Technical Center, students can earn credit towards the Basic Engine Technician Certificate (12 credits), and the chance to earn industry recognized credentials from the Equipment and Engine Training Council (EETC).
