

Clackamas Community College Advanced College Credit

Clackamas Community College (CCC) in partnership with area high schools provides opportunities for students to earn college credit in the Digital Media Communications program. There are multiple CCC classes that students may take through Advanced College Credit (ACC) program offered in your high school that help students progress toward a college certificate or degree.

Through the ACC program at Sabin-Schellenberg Professional Technical Center, students can earn credit toward an Entry Level Journalist Career Pathway Certificate (44 credits), which is part of the Journalism focus area of the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree, as well as towards the Video Production Technician Career Pathway Certificate (36 credits), which is part of the general Video Production focus area of the AAS Degree.
