



Advanced College Credit

Clackamas Community College (CCC) in partnership with area high schools provides opportunities for students to earn college credit in the Early Childhood Education & Family Studies Certificate. There are multiple CCC classes that students may take through Advanced College Credit (ACC) program offered in your high school that help students progress toward a college certificate or degree.

Through the ACC program at Sabin-Schellenberg Professional Technical Center, students can earn credit towards the Early Childhood Education & Family Studies Certificate (49-52 credits), which is half of the Associate of Applied Science degree in Early Childhood Education & Family Studies (90-93 credits).
