

Pre-Orientation Check List

Instructions: In order to receive your email invitation to the mandatory course orientation, please be sure to check off all of the items listed below.

1. Review all course materials on the website which include the following information:

- Course costs
- Academic requirements
 - Unofficial transcript requirement (WRD-098)
(MTH 50 is strongly recommended)

or

- Placement scores (WR 121)
- Non-academic requirements

Complete and/or gather documentation of the following:

- TB Test
- BLS/CPR certification (American Heart Association)
- Proof of immunization status
 - MMR (2 shots or blood titers)
 - Varicella (2 shots or blood titers)
 - Tdap (within ten years)
 - Hep B (3 shots or blood titers)
 - COVID-19

2. Apply or register as a Clackamas Community College student (if you are not already)

3. Submit your unofficial transcripts to healthsciences@clackamas.edu

4. Complete the online course application

Note: You will receive an email from healthsciences@clackamas.edu informing you of whether you have been approved for registration or if you have been placed on the waitlist. You will also receive an invitation to the virtual zoom Mandatory Orientation. Make sure to respond to Health Sciences email and confirm your seat for the Mandatory Orientation.

Required documentation/screenings in ACEMAPP:

- Criminal Background check
- Drug Screen
- Documentation of the following non-academic requirements
 - Immunizations/vaccines (MMR, Varicella, Tdap, HepB, COVID)
 - TB test
 - BLS/CPR Card through the American Heart Association
