Steps to apply to the Bilingual Teacher Pathway Program at PSU

Application Timeline:

The Bilingual Teacher Pathway Program (BTP) admits on a yearly timeline for a fall term start:

October: Applications open

April 1: Applications due

April - May: Faculty and community partners review your application

June: Admissions decisions communicated

August: One-on-one orientation with the program coordinator

September: Program start

Undergraduate Application Requirements:

Education:

- Admitted PSU student. If you are transferring to PSU, <u>apply to the university here</u>
- Complete 120 credits by the program start date
- Complete required prerequisite courses (Math 211 and 212, 213; LIB 428) with a C or better. *** If you cannot complete all of the prerequisite courses, you may be able to fit them into your schedule during the program

Testing:

- <u>NES Elementary Education Subtest I</u>: Reading and English Language Arts; Social Studies
- <u>NES Elementary Education Subtest II</u>: Math, Science, Arts, Health, and Fitness
- <u>ACTFL OPI language proficiency interview</u>
- Please note that we ask you to complete these tests prior to beginning the program in the fall if you cannot complete them prior to the application due date. A passing score is not required for admission to the BTP program.

Materials:

- Application to the program <u>submitted via tk20.</u>
- Résumé which includes your relevant work experience with youth in and educational setting
- One essay written in your first language and translated into your second language. Your essay should answer the following questions:

Why have you chosen teaching as a profession?

What has led you to his place in your life and what do you hope to accomplish? Please limit your essay to 500 words total.

u Three letters of recommendation submitted via the form in the application

Graduate Application Requirements:

Education:

 Complete required prerequisite courses (Math 211 and 212, 213; LIB 428) with a C- or better.

Testing:

- NES Elementary Education Subtest I: Reading and English Language Arts; Social Studies
- <u>NES Elementary Education Subtest II</u>: Math, Science, Arts, Health, and Fitness
- <u>ACTFL OPI language proficiency interview</u>
- Please note that we ask you to complete these tests prior to beginning the program in the fall if you cannot complete them prior to the application due date. A passing score is not required for admission to the BTP program.

Materials:

- Application to the program <u>submitted via slate</u>
- Unofficial transcripts from all institutions of higher education you have ever attended
- Résumé which includes your relevant work experience with youth in and educational setting
- One essay written in your first language and translated into your second language. Your essay should answer the following questions:

Why have you chosen teaching as a profession?

What has led you to his place in your life and what do you hope to accomplish? Please limit your essay to 500 words total.
