


Jorge Apodaca

VICE PRESIDENT CANDIDATES

The position of Vice President currently has no listed candidate. Write-in votes are accepted for this office using the following eligibility guidelines

1. Due to conflict of interest, no member of a Clackamas Community College classified staff bargaining unit, faculty bargaining unit, supervisor, administrator, classified, or confidential employee shall be allowed to run for or hold any student body office.
2. Any person running for an elected position must hold a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better and must be enrolled in a minimum of 2 credits at Clackamas Community College for the term that the elections take place.
3. Any person running must have served at least one term on ASGCCC or currently be a member to run for a position.

CONSTITUTION PROPOSED UPDATES

CURRENT

Section VIII - Vacancies

- 1.If both the President and Vice President positions should become vacant at the same time, the Secretary shall assume the presidency. The selection process outlined in the bylaws shall then be used to fill both the Vice President and the Secretary positions.
- 2.If any position other than President should have a mid-term vacancy, the selection process outlined in the bylaws shall be used to fill the position.

PROPOSED CHANGES*

Section VIII - Vacancies

- 1.If both the President and Vice President positions should become vacant at the same time, the Secretary shall assume the presidency. The selection process outlined in the bylaws shall then be used to fill both the Vice President and the Secretary positions.
 - a.In the event the Vice President does not wish to assume the role of President, the selection for President will be completed using the PVPATG as outlined in the bylaws.
- 2.If any position other than President or Vice President should have a mid-term vacancy, the selection process outlined in the bylaws shall be used to fill the position.
