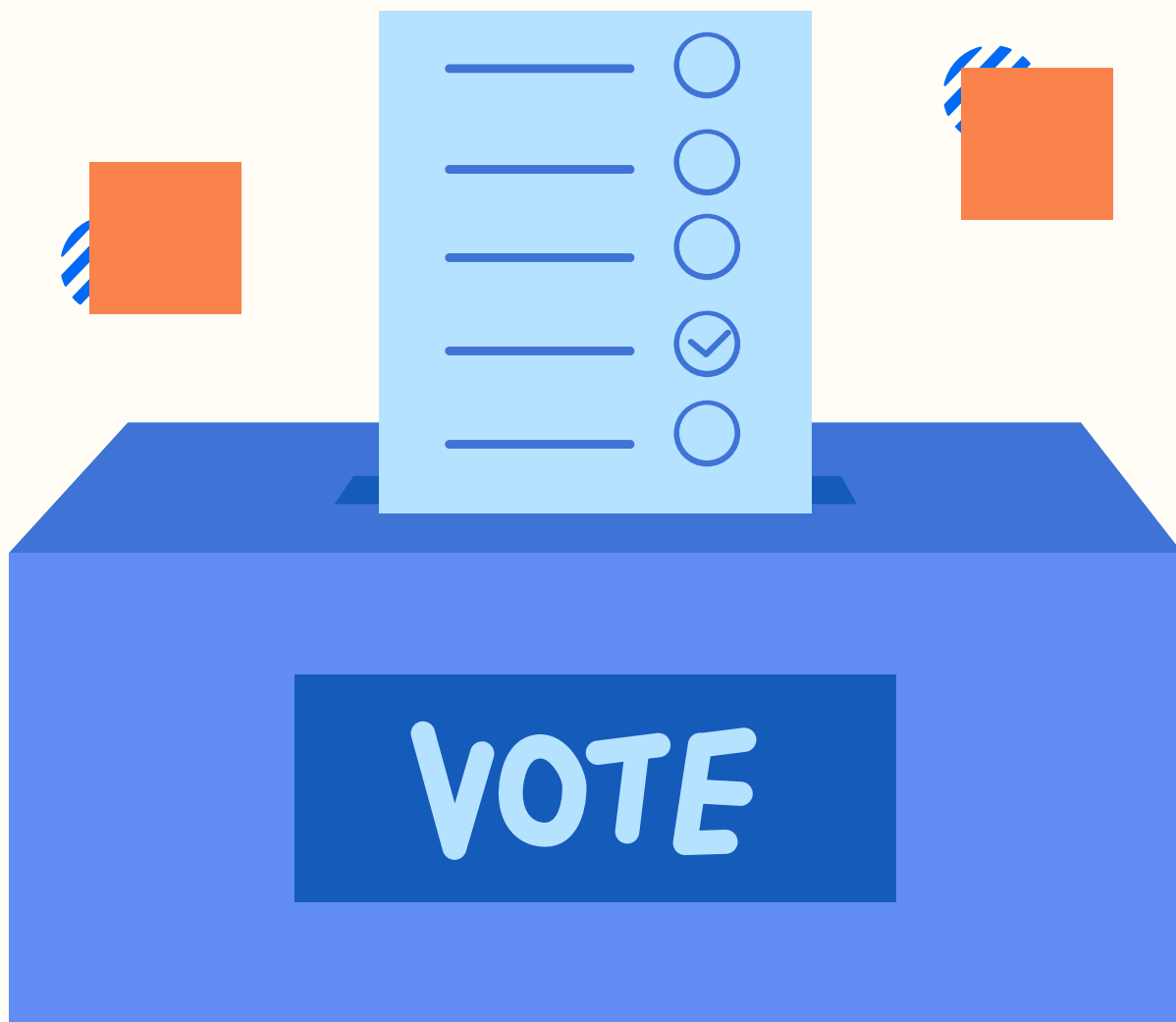

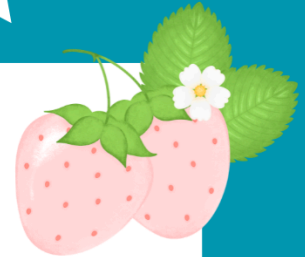

2. Any person running for an elected position must hold a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better and must be enrolled in a minimum of 2 credits at Clackamas Community College for the term that the elections take place.
3. Any person running must have served at least one term on ASGCCC or currently be a member to run for a position.
