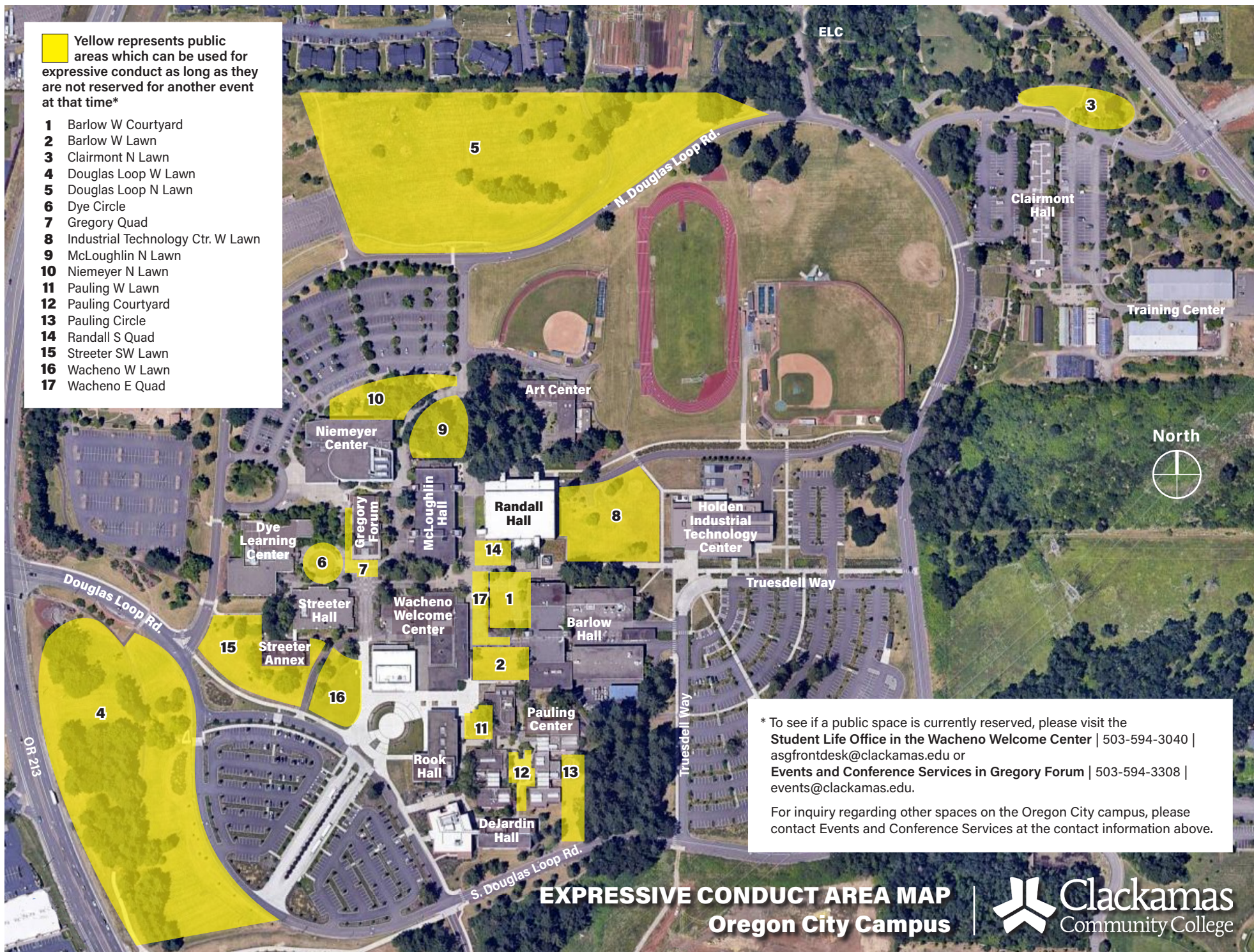

Expressive Conduct Area Map Oregon City Campus Written Description

The Oregon City Campus is located at 19600 Molalla Avenue, Oregon City, OR 97045.

This document is a detailed birds-eye view map of Oregon City Expressive Conduct Areas.

The map highlights in yellow the designated zones as Expressive Conduct Areas that can be used as long as they are not reserved for another event at that time:

#	Zone Name	Description and Location
1	Barlow W Courtyard	The paved area immediately east of the Wacheno Welcome Center and south of Randall Hall .
2	Barlow W Lawn	The grassy area immediately east of the Wacheno Welcome Center and south of the Barlow W Courtyard .
3	Clairmont Lawn	The wooded grassy area north of Clairmont Hall , just across Clairmont Drive .
4	Douglas Loop W Lawn	The grassy, wooded area immediately east and adjacent to OR 213 .
5	Douglas Loop N Lawn	The grassy, wooded area north of the North Douglas Loop Road .
6	Dye Circle	The outdoor amphitheater located between the Dye Learning Center , Streeter Hall , and Gregory Forum .
7	Gregory Quad	The outdoor space located outside the main entrance to Gregory Forum .
8	Industrial Technology Ctr. W Lawn	The open grassy area located directly between the Holden Industrial Technology Center and Randall Hall .
9	McLoughlin N Lawn	The grassy, wooded area north of McLoughlin Hall and east of the Art Center .

10	Niemeyer N Lawn	The grassy, wooded area north of the Niemeyer Center and adjacent to the yellow parking lot .
11	Pauling W Lawn	The grassy area between the Pauling Center and Roger Rook Hall .
12	Pauling Courtyard	The partially covered and wooded area southwest of the Pauling Center and north of DeJardin Hall .
13	Pauling Circle	The grassy, wooded area on the backside of the Pauling Center .
14	Randall S Quad	The paved area outside the south exit of Randall Hall .
15	Streeter SW Lawn	The grassy area surrounding the south side of Streeter Annex , adjacent to the Orange 1 parking lot .
16	Wacheno W Lawn	The grassy area immediately east and adjacent to the Streeter SW Lawn .
17	Wacheno E Quad	The paved area outside the east entrance/exit of the Wacheno Welcome Center and to the west of the Barlow Courtyard .
